The following documents or particulars must be attached to this application form:

- 1. A certified copy of the applicant's identity document and, in the case of a non-Namibian citizen, permanent residence permit or employment permit and also proof of residence in Namibia, or proof of domicile in Namibia, as the case may be.
- 2. If the applicant is a company, a certified copy of its registration documents.
- 3. Proof that the applicant operates a commercial or industrial undertaking or mine or is a *bona fide* farmer.
- 4. Proof of payment (receipt) of prescribed application fees (N\$100). Kindly note that the operating hours of the Cashier at Ministry of Mines and Energy are **08H00** to **12H00** during working days, therefore payments can only be made during the above mentioned hours.
- 5. In the case of storage facilities to be erected, final design or construction drawings of buildings, roadworks, structures and plant, details of bund walls, etc., conforming to minimum SANS Standards should be attached.
- 6. A signed declaration by the applicant that there is sufficient capital available for the operation of a consumer installation.
- 7. A written confirmation by the supplying wholesaler that it agrees to supply fuel to the applicant and a list of all buildings, structures and plant and any other item or assistance such wholesaler agrees to supply to the applicant in the event of a successful application.
- 8. If an environmental impact assessment (EIA) study has been conducted, a certified copy of the Environmental Clearance and the EIA document setting out the outcome of such study (applicable to underground storage tanks).

In the case of an application for a **petrol consumer installation**, a signed declaration by an accountant or auditor registered under the Public Accountants' and Auditors' Act, 1951 (Act No. 51 of 1951), that the applicant has for a consecutive period of at least three months consumed more than 10 000 litres of petrol per month and further proof must also be submitted that the 10 000 litres of petrol was obtained from the same supply point.
